

# Poetry KGRD

**The blank books from Emmanuel Books or Barebooks.com come with a choice of 28, 60, or 92 pages.** KGRD has 7 poems. The smallest book is way too big. So, you have some choices.

1. If you want a BIG K-5 poetry book, you can get the [8 ½ x 11"- 92 pager with cover](#). Paste in the KGRD poem on the bottom half of pages 2-8 and have the kid draw on the top half (or paste in his drawing).
2. You could get the [28 pager with cover](#) and just start a new volume every time they run out of pages.
3. If you have the cash, scan in the illustrations, type the retellings, and shutterfly it, yo!
4. I am also kind of digging the [60-page, ½ size book](#). My littles have trouble holding the big books, much less filling those pages with illustrations. I might do a volume 1, 2, 3 on that this round. I just don't know if it wants to lay flat. Will report back.

# Bible Book

**BIBLE BOOK K:** There are 36 Bible retellings/illustrations in the Kindergarten Bible Book, if you also include the 10 Commandments page and the wandering's map. The 28 page book won't be sufficient.

1. The 60 page ½ size book might work fine if you put pictures on one side and retellings on the other.
2. If you want a K-5 Bible book, like the K-5 Poetry book, get the 92-pager mentioned above and use this table of contents. [BIG K-5 OT book plan](#)
3. Alternatively, you could plan to slack and skip a few illustrations so that it all fits in the 28-pager. Tee-hee.
