

1. **L16 The first commandment of God is: I am the Lord thy God; thou shalt not have strange gods before Me.:** What is the first commandment of God?
2. **L16 By the first commandment we are commanded to offer to God alone the supreme worship that is due Him.:** What are we commanded by the first commandment?
3. **L16 We worship God by acts of faith, hope, and charity, and by adoring Him and praying to Him.:** How do we worship God?
4. **L16 A Catholic sins against faith by not believing what God has revealed, and by taking part in non-Catholic worship.:** How does a Catholic sin against faith?
5. **L16 The sins against hope are presumption and despair:** What are the sins against hope?
6. **L16 The chief sins against charity are hatred of God and of our neighbor, envy, sloth, and scandal.:** What are the chief sins against charity?
7. **L17 The 1st commandment does not forbid us to honor the saints in heaven, as long as we do not give them the honor that belongs to God alone.:** Does the first commandment forbid us to honor the saints in heaven?
8. **L17 When we pray to the saints we ask them to offer their prayers to God for us.:** When we pray to the saints what do we ask them to do?
9. **L17 We do not pray to the crucifix or to the images of Christ and of the saints, but to the persons of whom they remind us.:** Do we pray to the crucifix or to the images of Christ and of the saints?
10. **L18 The second commandment of God is: Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.:** What is the second commandment of God?
11. **L18 By the second commandment we are commanded always to speak with reverence of God, of the saints, and of holy things.:** What are we commanded by the second commandment?
12. **L18 By taking God's name in vain is meant that the name of God or the holy name of Jesus Christ is used without reverence.:** What is meant by taking God's name in vain?
13. **L18 Cursing is the calling down of some evil on a person, place, or thing.:** What is cursing?
14. **L18 The third commandment of God is: Remember thou keep holy the Lord's day.:** What is the third commandment of God?
15. **L18 By the third commandment we are commanded to worship God in a special manner on Sunday, the Lord's day.:** What are we commanded by the third commandment?
16. **L18 The Church commands us to worship God on Sunday by assisting at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.:** How does the Church command us to worship God on Sunday?
17. **L18 By the third commandment of God all unnecessary servile work on Sunday is forbidden.:** What is forbidden by the third commandment of God?
18. **L18 Servile work is that which requires labor of body rather than of mind.:** What is servile work?
19. **L19 The fourth commandment of God is: Honor thy father and thy mother.:** What is the fourth commandment of God?
20. **L19 By the fourth commandment we are commanded to respect and love our parents, to obey them in all that is not sinful, and to help them when they are in need.:** What are we commanded by the fourth commandment?
21. **L19 The fourth commandment forbids disrespect, unkindness, and disobedience to our parents and lawful superiors.:** What does the fourth commandment forbid?
22. **L19 The fifth commandment of God is: Thou shalt not kill.:** What is the fifth commandment of God?
23. **L19 By the fifth commandment we are commanded to take proper care of our own spiritual and bodily well-being and that of our neighbor.:** What are we commanded by the fifth commandment?
24. **L19 The fifth commandment forbids murder and suicide, and also fighting, anger, hatred, revenge, drunkenness, reckless driving, and bad example.:** What does the fifth commandment forbid?
25. **L20 The sixth commandment of God is: Thou shalt not commit adultery.:** What is the sixth commandment of God?
26. **L20 By the sixth commandment we are commanded to be pure and modest in our behavior.:** What are we commanded by the sixth commandment?
27. **L20 The sixth commandment forbids all impurity and immodesty in words, looks, and actions, whether alone or with others.:** What does the sixth commandment forbid?
28. **L20 The seventh commandment of God is: Thou shalt not steal.:** What is the seventh commandment of God?
29. **L20 By the seventh commandment we are commanded to respect what belongs to others.:** What are we commanded by the seventh commandment?
30. **L20 The seventh commandment forbids all dishonesty, such as stealing, cheating, unjust keeping of what belongs to others, and unjust damage to the property of others.:** What does the seventh commandment forbid?
31. **L20 We are obliged to restore to the owner stolen goods, or their value, whenever we are able.:** Are we obliged to restore to the owner stolen goods, or their value?
32. **L20 By the eighth commandment we are commanded to speak the truth in all things.:** What are we commanded by the eighth commandment?
33. **L20 The eighth commandment forbids lies and harming the name of another.:** What does the eighth commandment forbid?
34. **L20 The ninth commandment of God is: Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife.:** What is the ninth commandment of God?

35. **L20 By the ninth commandment we are commanded to be pure in thought and in desire.:** What are we commanded by the ninth commandment?
36. **L20 The ninth commandment forbids all thoughts and desires contrary to chastity.:** What is forbidden by the ninth commandment?
37. **L20 The tenth commandment of God is: Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods.:** What is the tenth commandment of God?
38. **L20 The tenth commandment forbids all desire to take or to keep unjustly what belongs to others, and also forbids envy at their success.:** What does the tenth commandment forbid?
39. **L21 The chief commandments, or laws, of the Church are these six:**  
**1. To assist at Mass on all Sundays and holydays of obligation.**  
**2. To fast and to abstain on the days appointed.**  
**3. To confess our sins at least once a year.**  
**4. To receive Holy Communion during the Easter time.**  
**5. To contribute to the support of the Church.**  
**6. To observe the laws of the Church concerning marriage.:** Which are the chief commandments, or laws, of the Church?
40. **L21 A Catholic who through his own fault misses Mass on a Sunday or holyday of obligation commits a mortal sin.:** What sin does a Catholic commit who through his own fault misses Mass on a Sunday or holyday of obligation?
41. **L21 The holydays of obligation in the United States are these six:**  
**Christmas Day (December 25)**  
**The Octave Day of Christmas (January 1)**  
**Ascension Thursday (40 days after Easter)**  
**Assumption (August 15)**  
**All Saints' Day (November 1)**  
**The Immaculate Conception (December 8):** Which are the holydays of obligation in the United States?
42. **L21 The Church obliges us to abstain from servile work on holydays of obligation, just as on Sundays, as far as we are able.:** What else does the Church oblige us to do on holydays of obligation?
43. **L21 A fast day is a day on which only one full meal is allowed, but in the morning and evening some food may be taken, the quantity and quality of which are determined by the approved local custom.:** What is a fast day?
44. **L21 A day of abstinence is a day on which we are not allowed the use of meat.:** What is a day of abstinence?
45. **L21 All baptized persons who have reached the use of reason and passed their fourteenth birthday are obliged to observe the abstinence days of the Church, unless excused or dispensed.:** Who are obliged to observe the abstinence days of the Church?
46. **L21 By the commandment to confess our sins at least once a year is meant that we are strictly obliged to make a good confession within the year, if we have a mortal sin to confess.:** What is meant by the commandment to confess our sins at least once a year?
47. **L22 A Catholic who neglects to receive Holy Communion worthily during the Easter time commits a mortal sin.:** What sin does a Catholic commit who neglects to receive Holy Communion worthily during the Easter time?
48. **L22 By the commandment to contribute to the support of the Church is meant that each of us must help to pay the expenses of the Church.:** What is meant by the commandment to contribute to the support of the Church?
49. **L22 The ordinary law of the Church to be observed at the wedding of a Catholic is this: A Catholic can be married only in the presence of an authorized priest and two witnesses.:** What is the ordinary law of the Church to be observed at the wedding of a Catholic?
50. **L23 A sacrament is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace.:** What is a sacrament?
51. **L23 There are seven sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist, Penance, Anointing of the Sick, Holy Orders, and Matrimony.:** How many sacraments are there?
52. **L23 The sacraments do give sanctifying grace.:** Do the sacraments give sanctifying grace?
53. **L23 Each of the sacraments also gives a special grace called sacramental grace.:** Does each of the sacraments also give a special grace?
54. **L23 The sacraments always give grace if we receive them properly.:** Do the sacraments always give grace?
55. **L23 Baptism and Penance are called sacraments of the dead because their chief purpose is to give the life of grace to souls dead through sin.:** Why are Baptism and Penance called sacraments of the dead?

57. **L23 He who knowingly receives a sacrament of the living in mortal sin commits a mortal sin of sacrilege.:** What sin does he commit who knowingly receives a sacrament of the living in mortal sin?
58. **L23 Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders can be received only once because they imprint on the soul a spiritual mark which lasts forever.:** Why can Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders be received only once?
59. **L24 Baptism is the sacrament that gives our souls the new life of grace by which we become children of God.:** What is Baptism?
60. **L24 Baptism takes away original sin; and also actual sins, if there be any, and all the punishment due to them.:** What sins does Baptism take away?
61. **L24 The priest is the usual minister of Baptism, but if there is danger that someone will die without Baptism, anyone else may and should baptize.:** Who can administer Baptism?

62. **L24 I would give Baptism by pouring ordinary water on the forehead of the person to be baptized, saying while pouring it: "I baptize thee in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.":** How would you give Baptism?
63. **L25 Confirmation is the sacrament through which the Holy Ghost comes to us in a special way and enables us to profess our faith as strong and perfect Christians and soldiers of Jesus Christ.:** What is Confirmation?
64. **L25 The bishop is the usual minister of Confirmation:** Who is the usual minister of Confirmation?
65. **L25 All Catholics should be confirmed in order to be strengthened against the dangers to salvation and to be prepared better to defend their Catholic faith.:** Why should all Catholics be confirmed.
