First Grade Reading Practice

If you use 100EZ, you must **TEAM READ** with your child. He won't have enough phonograms to read independently. 100EZ mixes it up and holds off the "short –e" and the letter "b" until Lessons 52 and 54, respectively.

Once your child hits **Lesson 54** of 100EZ, he will have all the phonograms necessary to independently read the *Little Angel Reader A*. It's really late in the year because the **Little Angel Reader A** teaches all of the consonant and short vowels first.

By the time the child hits Lesson 67 of 100EZ, the child has enough sight words to independently read the **Primer** and half of *This is Our Home* from the *Faith and Freedom Readers*.

Once you have reached Lesson 89, you will have enough phonograms learned to use the rest of the Little Angel Readers. You may also continue *This is Our Home* and *Here We Are Again*.

The following books assume that your child knows all his phonograms, which won't be true unless you go all the way through the *Little Angel Readers*. Alternatively, if you kept going on the *Faith and Freedom Readers*, the child may know most of the words in these books by sight, not sounding them out.
